Clinton County School District 2022-2023 Professional Development Schedule In-District Training Days (August 1-5 & 8)

All certified employees must complete 24 hours of professional development during the 2022-23 school year. This year the training calendar also includes two work days that must be completed before the school year begins. Please remember that professional development (4 days) and work days (2 day) must be completed before school begins, or you will have to use sick days. There is no flexibility for these days, so each staff member must be in attendance in order to get credit **OR** provide a certificate from an approved summer training prior to professional development for equivalent PD credit hours (may replace Monday, August 8 or other work days within the calendar for 2022-2023 school year). Four additional work days have been put in the school calendar for this year on January 3, March 10, April 28, and May 19. Faculty will be continuing to revise and refine curriculum during work days, so attendance at each work day is also mandatory.

All PD sessions will be from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. with a one-hour break for lunch unless otherwise noted.

Opening Day for all certified and classified employees will begin at the Clinton County Learning Center. Breakfast will be served from 7:00 to 8:00 in the ECC cafeteria. After a short district program, staff will be dismissed to go to their individual schools.

*EDU 503: Teacher Induction Follow-Up – Second Year Teachers

In Fall 2022, EDU 503 will be offered. This is a wonderful follow-up to the New Teacher Academy. This course is free to all New Teacher Academy participants. There is a \$65 charge for applying to graduate school. Some districts are reimbursing teachers for that \$65 in return for completing the course.

- This course will have teachers identify a problem of practice, research best practices on the topic, identify a classroom action plan, and implement the plan in their classroom. Teachers will record the lessons and receive feedback from peers.
- Another assignment has students identify a book related to their problem of practice and participate in a book chat.
