## 12<sup>th</sup> grade

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**12<sup>th</sup> grade: Advanced**– If student completed and passed English I and Algebra I in 8<sup>th</sup> grade

### Comprehensive Requirements (27 credits):

Language Arts – 4 credits (English I, English II, English III, English IV)

Mathematics – 4 credits (Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II, Advanced Mathematics Course)

Social Studies – 4 credits (Econ and Gov't, World Civ, U.S. History, Social Studies Elective)

Science – 4 credits (Integrated Science, Biology I, Chemistry, Science Elective)

Health – ½ credit

Physical Education – ½ credit (or JROTC)

Humanities – 1 credit

Foreign Language – 2 credits

Electives – 7 credits

### Standard Requirements (25 credits):

Language Arts – 4 credits (English I, English II, English III, English IV)

Mathematics – 3 credits (Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II)

Social Studies – 3 credits (Econ and Gov't, World Civ, U.S. History)

Science – 3 credits (Integrated Science, Biology I, Chemistry or ICP: Intro to Chemistry/Physics)

Health – ½ credit

Physical Education – ½ credit (or JROTC)

Humanities – 1 credit

Electives – 10 credits
