SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

AWARD: Seven \$1,000 scholarships to graduating seniors, GED recipients, or students who are currently enrolled in college or tech schools that live in modular or manufactured homes in Kentucky.

This completed application must be accompanied by an original, type-written 300-word essay explaining the “impact of factory-built housing on your life,” a copy of your high school or GED or college transcript, and three letters of reference from business persons, clergy or community leaders. Only one of these may be from a school administrator or teacher. You may copy the included sheet for your letters of reference OR attach your individually typed letters of reference. For further information, please contact Carolyn Conway, Director of Programs and Communications, KMHI Office, 2170 US Highway 127 South, Frankfort, Kentucky 40601, (502) 223-0490. In order to be considered, the complete application, with essay and references, must be post-marked to KMHI by April 1, 2018.

Selection is based on the essay, participation and grades in school and community, honors, recommendations, and personal goals. Judges’ decision is final. The winner may attend a university, college, technical, or vocational school. Alternates will be selected and move to first place should a winner be disqualified, receive a full scholarship from another source, or decide not to further his/her education. A tie may result in a call for personal interviews.

Recipients and those who are not chosen for this scholarship will be notified via mail towards the end of May.
