Albany Elementary School PBIS Tier 1 and Tier 2

End of Year Evaluation 2021-2022

Our Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports Teams met on May 18, 2022, to evaluate our Tier 1 and Tier 2 Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports programs at Albany Elementary School. We used the SWPBIS Tiered
Fidelity Inventory (Version 2.1) from the PBIS Network to evaluate our programs at Albany Elementary School.

Our Tier 1 Program received an overall score of 30 out of 30 points possible, or 100% of School Wide PBIS Implementation. Our Tier 2 Program received a score of 22 out of 26 points possible, or 85% of School Wide PBIS Implementation. Albany Elementary School will apply for Silver Recognition of Fidelity Standards with the Kentucky PBIS Network for the 2021-2022 school year. After viewing our parent and teacher surveys and our end of the year evaluations, our teams decided to make the following changes to our programs for the 2022-2023 school year:

PBIS Tier 1

Our team discussed making adding more options for our student reward system in for next year. We also discussed adding a student voice component to our program that would enable our students to have a voice in the rewards and systems in place.

PBIS Tier 2

Tier 2 interventions will expand to include 5% of our students at AES that need additional support.

PBIS Tier 3

Next year, we will work toward fully implementing the Tier 3 program at AES.
